

Lober Honored with Outstanding Missourian Award

Lori Lober is a survivor. Diagnosed with cancer in 2000, Lori fought her way from a stage 4 diagnosis to currently being cancer free. While undertaking this terrible fight Lori also found time to help others. In 2002 Lori's husband, John of Provence Homes by John Lober built a new home in Staley Farms to benefit cancer research. After the bills were paid the proceeds from the sale of the home went to cancer research. In 2004, Lori and John repeated this effort at the National and the proceeds from the sale of this home went to cancer research.

Lori is chairman of the Touched by Cancer Foundation, a not for profit organization devoted to raising funds for cancer research. Through Lori's efforts several hundred thousand dollars has been raised and given to universities in Kansas and Missouri to help fund their efforts.
